

ATTENTION!

Dear resident,

As stated in the current federal law, when entering Germany from a COVID19 high-risk country as classified by the Robert-Koch-Institute (QRCODE →), you have to follow some **rules**:



- Until you are proven negative by a test that you are not infected with the Sars-CoV2-Virus, you have to isolate yourself. This means, that you have to stay in your flat until you got a negative test result from a COVID19-test.
 - This test has to be done within 72 hours after entry.
- Always wear mouth-nose-protection on the floor and in the common rooms. This is to protect others!
- Make sure to only enter the common rooms (kitchen and bath)
 when absolutely necessary, ALONE and wearing a mask all the
 time. When entering, flip the sign at the door, so others know that
 it is occupied. When leaving a common room, make sure to open
 the windows for 3-5 minutes to ventilate the room and reverse
 the status-sign so others may use the room. Also clean the
 surfaces with appropriate cleaning.
